HOW TO REGISTER

The most efficient and preferred method of registration is online at <u>NorfolkRec.com</u>. Registration by mail or inperson requires a completed paper registration form (which can be found at NorfolkRec.com or in the office) along with payment by check or cash. Registrations mailed in early will be NOT be processed early. Pap

Advance Registration is required for all programs unless noted. *Registrations are not transferable.*

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

When Registering online, receipts are automatically emailed confirming registration. With mail–in registrations, you will be contacted ONLY if there is a question about your registration or if you do not get into the class.

WAITLISTS

If a program is full, please add **your child's name** to the waitlist if the program is for them, or your name, if the program is for you. If a spot opens up, those wait-listed will be notified of their pending spot. Prompt responses are required due to time restraints. No reply or a late reply may forfeit your place on the waitlist.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are only given if a program is canceled by Norfolk Recreation, for a documented medical reason, or if there is a change in a school schedule. For any other reason, with enough advance notice, if we can fill your spot from our waitlist, a refund will be given less a processing fee, but this takes time.
